#### Old Business:

1). The Planning Commission secretary sent photos (via email) of a nearby Consumers Energy wind energy installation located near Jonesville MI (Hillsdale county). This installation contains 60 turbines. A YouTube video link was also included which showed wind turbines (located in Illinois) being destroyed by a powerful tornado (date of storm May 4, 2024). The video demonstrated "catastrophic" failure and potential distance in which turbine parts could be thrown. The worksheet created to summarize ongoing discussion concerning wind turbine was also discussed. This worksheet will be updated after each Planning Commission meeting to include items discussed at the meeting.

Planning Commission member Julie Murphy provided copies of Sanilac Township (Sanilac county Michigan) Wind Energy (commercial scale) zoning ordinance. Specific items that could be included in our proposed Wind Energy such as set-back distances was discussed. Members discussed hosting a local workshop for surrounding Planning Commission to create a "uniform" Wind Energy ordinance as commercial scale installation could be sited in multiple townships. Since each township creates zoning ordinances to address the need specific to their township, any coordinated zoning uniformity is not warranted.

Planning Commission members were asked to review other township zoning ordinance for additional information which may be applied in Exeter Township.
